## PARTNERS IN MINISTRY (PIM) CERTIFICATE

The Partners in Ministry (PIM) certificate program was developed out of a conviction that married couples called into vocational ministry should share the vision to serve alongside each other. EAST recognises the vital contributions women have in enhancing their husbands' ministries, and seeks to inspire and equip women to embrace this calling.

The PIM program is designed to encourage spouses to grow in biblical knowledge, Christian character, and ministry competence. It consists of both **classes** and Mentoring Groups. Classes are held on Monday mornings, followed by Mentoring Group sessions.

### PROGRAM EXPLANATION

PIM candidates are required to attend the following core classes:

- LMC 321 Being a Partner in Ministry (2 credits)
- BLS 301 Old Testament Survey (2 credits)
- BLS 351 New Testament Survey (2 credits)

In addition to the above six credits, all PIM candidates may select ten more elective credits from a variety of class categories. Refer to the table on the following page for details.
